READ THIS

"You must fear the Lord your God and worship him and cling to him. Your oaths must be in his name alone. He alone is your God, the only one who is worthy of your praise, the one who has done these mighty miracles that you have seen with your own eyes. When your ancestors went down into Egypt, there were only seventy of them. But now the Lord your God has made you as numerous as the stars in the sky!" – Deuteronomy 10:20-22

THINK ABOUT THIS

In our world today, it is so easy to fix our eyes on things other than God. Especially right now with what is happening in our country. Our schools are having longer breaks and restaurants can only do to-go orders. It can seem like everything can be just a little scary and sometimes, if we're being real, that can mean that it's hard to trust God.

What do you think God is trying to teach us through this passage?

He is everything. He is everything we want everything we need and He is enough. We don't have to be afraid, we can have courage. We can trust Him! We don't need the things society provides to meet our needs and desires, God alone can accomplish that. TALK ABOUT THIS

READ THIS

There's no need to fear for I'm your God. I'll give you strength. I'll help you. I'll hold you steady, keep a firm grip on you." – Isaiah 41:9b-10

THINK ABOUT THIS

Have you ever received a gift card? Maybe for your birthday or Christmas? It's so exciting because you are able to use a gift card to buy whatever you want, as long as it's within the price limit of the card you received. A girl named Emma received a gift card for her birthday, so she thought very carefully about how she wanted to spend her money. She went to the store and found a doll right away that she liked, but she wanted to be sure she was making the right choice. So she walked down every aisle to make sure she was able to look at every item in the toy section. After much thought she was sure she wanted the doll she found at the beginning of her shopping trip. She paid for it and took it home.

Emma was very proud of her doll and took extra special care of it and named it Sally. She put her initials on Sally's foot and took it with her everywhere she went – to school, to sleepovers, and even on family trips. Emma wanted to keep Sally safe.

Did you know that God chose you? Just like Emma chose Sally, God chose you to be his son or daughter! He picked you, he hasn't dropped you! He takes special care of you and goes with you wherever you go! He promises to make you strong, and you don't have to be afraid, because He will give you strength! And he chooses to be by your side every day of your life as long as you follow him!

You must go everywhere I send you, and you must say everything I tell you to say. Don't be afraid of anyone, because I am with you to protect you," says the Lord. – Jeremiah 1:4-8
